#### **Program Components:**

#### I. College and Career Interns

Shore Way to College Interns are located at each of the three participating schools. The interns will support students with goal setting, college and career research, academic tracking and tutoring referrals. Students will have access to the CACI to develop an individualized plan setting short, intermediate and long-term goals for success.

## II. College Prep Class: Kids'2'College Program

The college prep class is a six week course developed by the Sallie Mae Foundation to provide students with a wide range of information about college and to explore careers. The goal of the class is to help students make the connection between college and job opportunities.

The College Prep Class is offered two days per week at two different locations.

#### III. College Tours

Shore Way to College students have the opportunity to become comfortable on a college campus by attending several college tours. Tours will be taken of the three local universities (Wor Wic Community College, University of Maryland Eastern Shore, Salisbury University) and also two trips will be taken to other Universities across the State of Maryland.

### IV. Tutoring

Tutoring is available two days per week in multiple locations within the community and at school.
